Stockton signs biofungicide distribution agreement with Syngenta in Australia

The Stockton Group (STK, Petach Tikva, Israel) announced the signing of a commercialization and distribution agreement with Syngenta in Australia. The agreement gives Syngenta exclusive distribution rights for STK's Timorex Gold biofungicide in Australia and New Zealand. The product will be manufactured and supplied by STK and marketed and distributed by Syngenta under STK's brand.

The Timorex Gold trial program was managed for STK by Grosafe Chemicals Limited, and Grosafe will continue to support STK in product development, efficacy trials, and technical matters, STK says. Grosafe will also hold the registration for Timorex Gold in New Zealand.

Timorex Gold will complement a comprehensive Syngenta fungicide portfolio, adding a product that is certified by organic associations worldwide and leaves no residues in the harvested produce, according to STK.
